

SNP BENEFIT PACKAGE PLAN

Medicaid managed care provides a number of services members get in addition to those received with regular Medicaid. SNPs will provide or arrange for most services needed. A few services do not need PCP referral. These include emergency care, family planning/HIV testing and counseling, and specific “self referral” services, including those received from within the plan and some that a client can choose to go to any Medicaid provider of the service. (See description below) Services using Medicaid card can be received from any provider that takes Medicaid. For a specific care need encourage clients enrolled in a SNP to contact their PCP or SNP case management staff.

Benefits From a SNP OR With a Medicaid Card

There are some services SNP members can choose where to get the care. Members can get these by using SNP Plan membership card. SNP members can also go to providers who will take the Medicaid Benefit card. *Members do not need a referral from a PCP to get these services.*

Family Planning

Available from any doctor or clinic that takes Medicaid and offers family planning services.

Available from SNP family planning providers as well. Either way, members do not need a referral from a PCP.

HIV Testing & Counseling

Available from SNP doctors or from doctors or clinics that take Medicaid.

Does not need a referral when as part of a family planning visit.

HIV testing and counseling services any time from SNP providers, if contact PCP first.

TB Diagnosis and Treatment

Available from PCP or a local public health agency for diagnosis and/or treatment. Members do not need a referral to go to a county public health agency.
